APA Formatting Requirements

Title page:

- 1. Running head should be flush left and should look like this: Running head: TITLE OF YOUR ESSAY (no more than 50 characters in length). Page number 1 should be in the upper right-hand corner.
- 2. Title information should be centered in the upper half of the page, and the font should be 12-pt. Times New Roman (no bolding, italics, underlining, or abnormal font size). Title information should include the full title of the essay and the author's name. All text should be double-spaced.

General:

- 3. Header on all pages except for the title page should be flush left and should look like this: TITLE OF YOUR ESSAY. Page numbers should be flush right in the upper right-hand corner.
- 4. On the first page, the title of the paper should be centered and not bolded, italicized, or underlined.
- 5. The essay should start on the second page and use double spacing and 12-pt. Times New Roman font.
- 6. Margins should be 1 inch on all sides.
- 7. Direct quotations should include the author (or title if there is no author), the date, and the specific part of the source (page number, paragraph number, or section title).
- 8. The list of works cited should be on a separate page titled "References" (centered without quotation marks and not bolded, italicized, or underlined).
- 9. All entries on the References page should be listed in alphabetical order by the author's last name.
- 10. Each bibliography entry on the References page should be ordered according to <u>APA formatting style requirements</u>.
